This letter and the materials attached are the only communication that we will be sending to invite you to make application for the Nebraska "**Textbook Loan**" Program for 2017-2018. The reason for the single invitation is that we must submit your application to the Office of the Public School District by January 15, 2018. **Therefore, any applications received after the Thursday, January 11 deadline, cannot be accepted.**

A section of Nebraska law allows parents of students attending approved non-public schools to request the loan of textbooks from the Public School District in which their non-public school is located for their student to use in the non-public school s/he attends. The number of books available to be borrowed depends on the funds allocated by the Nebraska unicameral, not the local Public School District. However, we can only request texts used in the Public School District. WE MAKE ALL OF OUR REQUESTS TO THE MILLARD SCHOOLS.
